### **Drain your water**

Drain water from boat, motor, live wells and bait buckets before leaving the lake.

### **Clean your rig**

Remove plants, mud and invasive species from your boat, trailer and equipment.

### **Dry it off**

Sponge out water in live wells and bilge areas. Leave all drain plugs out.

**DISPOSE** of invasive species and unwanted bait, including minnows, leeches and worms in the TRASH.

MN statute requires lifts, dock and associated equipment to be out of the water for 21 days before moving to a different waterbody. Over-wintering used docks and lifts provides increased assurance that invasive species are not being moved.

Buying or selling a used dock or lift?

To comply with the Otter Tail County Dock and Riparian Use Ordinance, a dock, pier, wharf, or boat lift must be registered with the Otter Tail County Land & Resource Management Office before being moved from one body of water to another.
